

## About Us

Established on the 7th day of November, 1983, K.C. Das Commerce College began its humble origin as an evening college at Sonaram H.S. & Multipurpose School, Bharalumukh, Guwahati. Subsequently on 30th November, 1994, the college shifted to its permanent campus at Chatribari where it is presently positioned.

The college was instituted with the financial assistance provided by the erstwhile President of the Governing Body, Sri Ramesh Chandra Chaudhury. It has been named in the cherished memory of his father, late Keshab Chandra Das, an educationist of repute, who was Inspector of Schools, Assamin the 1930s.

Presently, the college has thirteen departments and imparts learning to approximately twenty eight hundred students with an efficient and dedicated teaching staff. It has an excellent ambience and an efficient administration. The internal quality assurance cell (IQAC) of college was established on 16th June 2003. ### Admissions

#### **Procedure**

- Admission into the college is made strictly in order of merit and is governed by the college admission rules.
- No application form will be accepted after the last date as notified and all incomplete application forms will stand automatically rejected.
- ➤ The college follows the Reservation policy of the Government and the segregation of seats as per quota are:

As per Govt. O.M. No. AHE 250/2014/1, dated 05.06.2014 a maximum 5% of the seats may be earmarked as per break up given below :

- a) 2% for sports persons of sports recognized by IOA/SAI and also have represented District/State etc.
- b) 1% for wards of employees of the college
- c) 1% for NCC/Scouts/Guides
- d) 1% for the students with achievements in cultural activities.

These above mentioned seats are to be setteled on the basis of merit list of students concerned in each category.

#### How to apply?

Application for admission should be made in the prescribed application form issued by the college office on payment of Rs.300/-.

## Infrastructure

#### Library

The college library is spacious with a reading room which has a seating capacity for about 150 readers. It has a collection of over twenty thousand books in different subjects. Latest publications are continuously added to the existing collection to equip students with a wide range of academic material. The college library provides user services through computers; it is equipped with the latest SOUL 2.0 software, besides barcoding and internet facility.

The library has access to e-resources through the "National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content" funded by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. It also subscribes various journals of national repute and a number of prominent national and regional dailies. Current magazines and periodicals are also a part of its subscription.

The Library Book Bank facility caters to the needs of the economically under privileged students of the society.

The library opens for six hours from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. every day.

#### **Computer Centre**

The College has a well-equipped Computer Centre. It has 26 computers with updated software and hardware. The centre is available for the students for accessing internet, practice and preparation of projects. The centre has uninterrupted power backup and fully air-conditioned laboratories.

#### Conference-cum-Seminar Room

A conference-cum-seminar room fully air-conditioned with LCD projection facilities is an addition to the existing infrastructure.

#### Classrooms

The college has an educational area comprising of twenty-five classrooms which are generally equipped with microphone facility, smart boards, ceiling-mounted LCD projectors, roll-down screens and green boards.

#### STUDENTS' WELFARE FUND AND FEE CONCESSION

The Students' Welfare Fund renders financial assistance to needy students towards their tuition fees. On application to the Principal, an amount not exceeding the annual tuition fees is granted to the needy students, whose father's / guardian's annual income does not exceed

Rs. 3600/- (Rupees three thousand and six hundred only). The college also gives financial aid to students affected by natural calamities like

earthquake, flood etc. Monetary support is also extended to students participating in various competitions at the State, National or International level.




